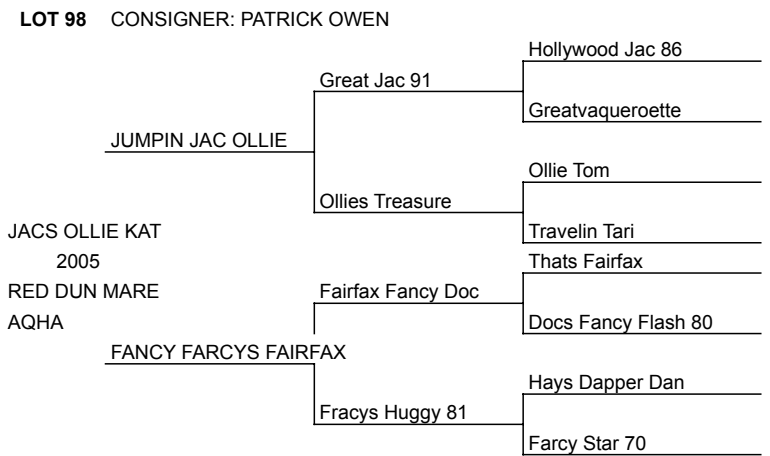
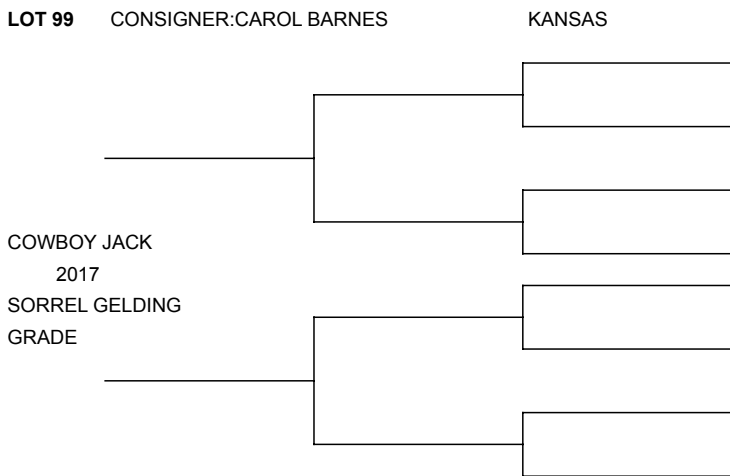


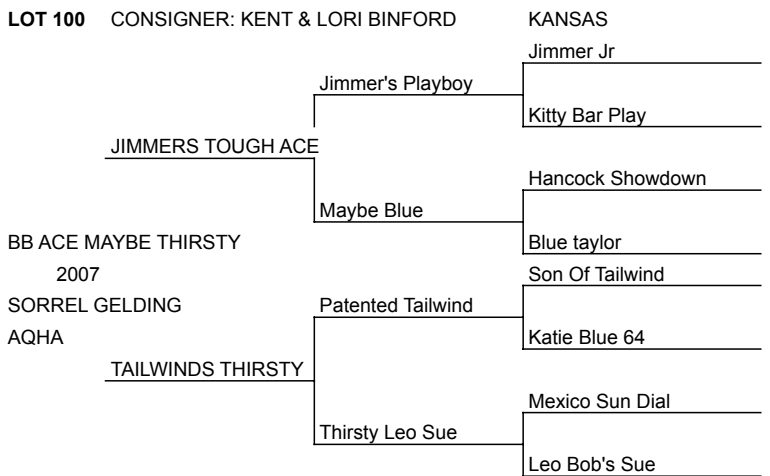
Genuine Red Boon 16 is 5 months bred. She is bred too Crazy Maga Cat son of Metallic Cat.



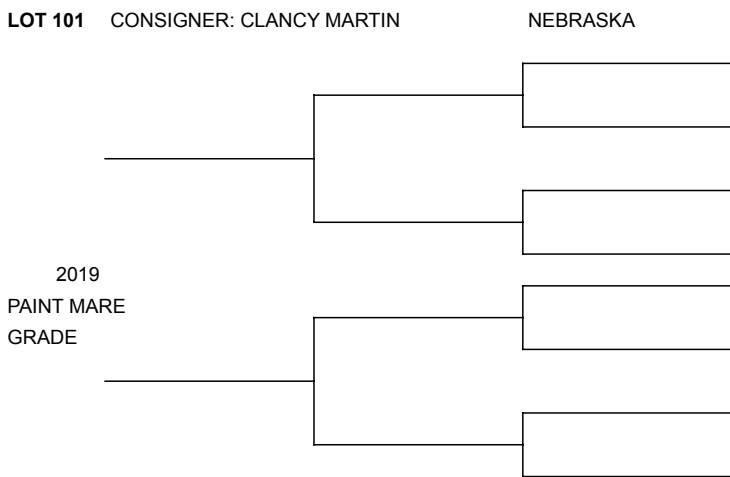

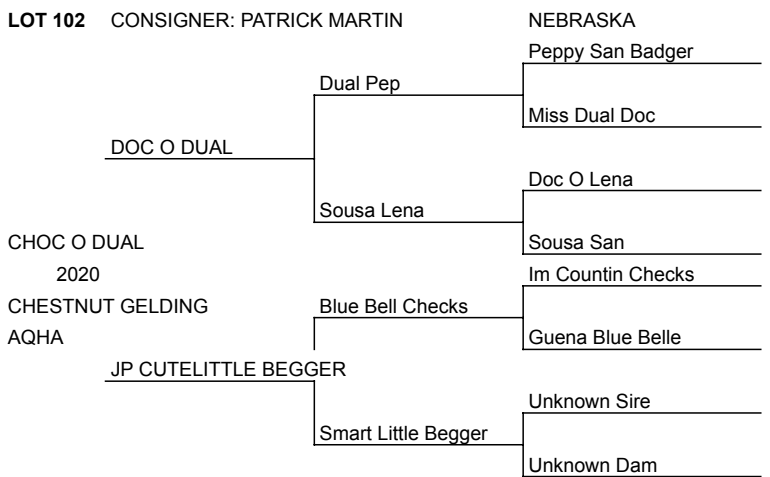

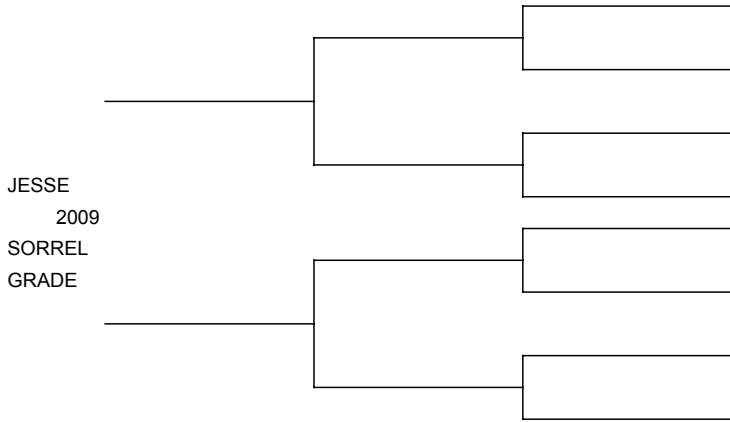


13+ hand paint quarter pony mare. Grandpa has been riding her down the road and the grandkids have been riding her in the arena with grandpa's tutelage.



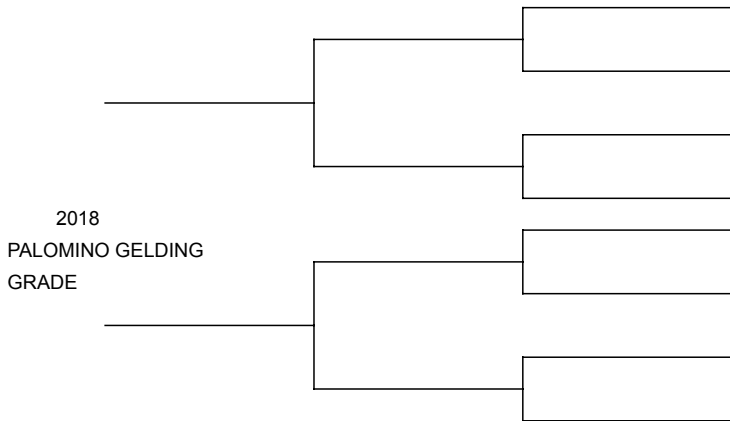

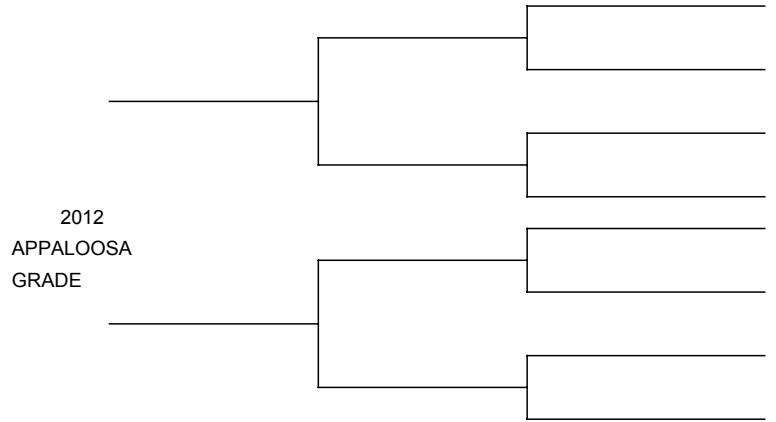

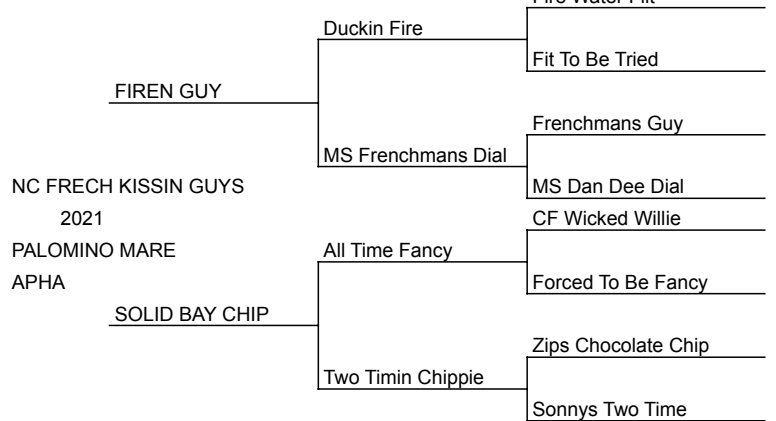
Big stout gelding that has done everything on the ranch. Started heading & healing.
